The Queen's Park and the Great War project has identified 227 Queen's Park members and players who served in the forces in World War One. Details of 129 of these men are included in Appendixes 1, 2 and 3 but little information is available about the remaining 97 individuals who survived the conflict.

It is known that the 97 men were members of Queen's Park Football Club. A few may have been non-playing members but it is likely that the vast majority will have played for one or more of Queen's Park's four elevens at some point. The club's records were destroyed by fire in later years and the only significant sources of information available about the players from that time are -

- contemporary newspaper reports;
- Scottish Football Association records listing players registered as part of the first team squad; and
- Richard Robinson's book "History of the Queen's Park Football Club 1867-1917".

There are few references anywhere to men who played for the club's minor elevens.
